

**NATIONAL TAIWAN UNIVERSITY**  
**Directives for Handling Posters and Other Forms of**  
**Expression on Campus**

July 01, 2014 Amended and passed by the 2,818<sup>th</sup> Administrative Meeting

- Article 1 The hanging and placement of posters and other forms of expression (including flags, banners, ribbons, 3-D structures, advertisements, etc.) on campus shall be handled in accordance with the National Taiwan University (NTU or “the University”) *Directives for Handling Posters and Other Forms of Expression on Campus* (“the Directives”).
- Article 2 The hanging of posters and other forms of expression within and around buildings (including on exterior walls and in surrounding cleaning areas) shall be handled by each building’s managing unit.
- Article 3 Those who hang posters or promotional materials or hand out leaflets in exterior public areas of the campus without permission will be banned by the Office of General Affairs, and the confiscated items will be disposed of as waste.
- Article 4 Student club activity posters intended for placement outside of NTU buildings shall be handled by the Office of Student Affairs in conjunction with the Office of General Affairs. If faculty members are involved in the events being posted or announced, the Office of Academic Affairs or their college/department shall coordinate the handling.
- Article 5 Managing units shall require the responsible person to remove any noncompliant posters and other forms of expression they put up. In the event that such materials must be forcefully removed, the managing unit may ask the Office of General Affairs to send support personnel and offer assistance.
- Article 6 The Office of General Affairs may consult the Office of Student Affairs or the relevant managing unit(s) before forcefully removing posters and other forms of expression in accordance with Article 3 herein.
- Article 7 The Directives shall be passed by the Administrative Meeting and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
