Notice on Exterior Wall Maintenance for Buildings on
Campus

December 25, 2003 Amended and passed by the 1st General Affairs Meeting, Academic Year 2003

- Article 1 The National Taiwan University (NTU or “the University”) *Notice on Exterior Wall Maintenance for Buildings on Campus* (“the Notice”) is formulated to help maintain the campus landscape, preserve historic sites, and ensure the completeness of historic buildings.
- Article 2 The Notice shall apply to all buildings located on the Main Campus.
- Article 3 No additions or modifications may be added to the exterior walls of any building in a way that alters its appearance, except where an application detailing the relevant supporting measures is submitted in accordance with the applicable administrative procedures to the Office of General Affairs, who may invite the competent unit(s) to perform on-site inspections.
- Article 4 The word ‘additions’ is defined as any objects that may alter the appearance of a building, such as air conditioners, pipelines, signboards, steel gates, rain shelters, hooks, etc.
- Article 5 Each unit shall propose improvement measures for existing additions as soon as possible in order to comply with University policy.
